Student Agreement:

- I understand that Open Campus is established as an educational tool to develop my responsibilities in being at the proper place at the proper time under my own initiative.
- I understand that I must check into my study hall, then sign out and sign in at the office.
- I understand that I must be on time for my next class following my open campus or lose privileges for the next week.
- I understand that I cannot have grades of “D” or “F” and if I do I will not be allowed open campus.
- I understand that I may have open campus 1 period per day and at lunch, unless the principal allows additional class periods because of scheduling and special circumstances.
- I understand I need to attend school to have this privilege, I understand each week my individual attendance needs to be above a 94%. If I do not reach this, I will not be allowed to have open campus until 94% is obtained.
- No one is allowed to ride with me if I am given permission to drive.
- I understand that if I have any infraction of alcohol, tobacco, marijuana, or controlled substance rules or laws shall be cause for immediate suspension of privileges. Nine weeks for the first offense, remainder of the year for the second offense and disciplinary action will be taken based on the discipline matrix.
- I understand that any legal court adjudication resulting in probation or diversionary program conditions shall be cause for immediate and permanent revocation of privileges.

Each day while open campus is in effect the student must:

1. Report to study hall, no exceptions
2. Sign out and sign in at the office
3. Exit and enter the school building quietly and without disrupting others

**Failure to follow the rules and guidelines stated above will result in Open Campus being
REVOKED**

Parent Agreement:

I accept responsibility for my student’s personal action while participating in the senior open campus program. I understand that if my student experiences academic, disciplinary, or attendance issues, or if the Administration does not feel that the program is in the best interest of my student, that student will be unenrolled from open campus. The decision to remove a student from the program is the responsibility of the Administration and is not negotiable.
